Please come prepared to discuss any evaluation ratings you think should be changed for a material's evaluation criteria (evaluation ratings include the “strong, moderate, concerning, challenging” designations for each evaluation criteria: access, sorting/processing compatibility, REM etc.). Note that this

portion of discussion may include materials not yet assigned to lists. Be prepared to note the specific material, the evaluation rating you'd like to discuss, the # that they are assigned on the Evaluation Matrix, and the list that they are currently assigned to (or note if flagged for "needs further evaluation").

iii. Q #3: Would additional subdivision of certain material categories improve the statewide lists?

1. Please come prepared to discuss any suggestions for further subdivision and why. Be prepared to note the specific material, the # that they are assigned on the Evaluation Matrix, and the list that they are currently assigned to (or note if flagged for "needs further evaluation").
